Video Specialist- Seasonal Position

Staff Purpose: The Video Specialist seeks to lead and serve as a faithful part of God's work in and through the ministry of Glen Lake. The Video Specialist serves on a ministry team dedicated and committed to a team approach to the ministry entrusted to us.

Job Summary: The Video Specialist pursues furthering the mission of the camp through the planning, production, and delivery of video. Design and deliver safe, fun, and age/ability appropriate video.

Duties: (include but not limited to)

Capture Video

Use camp equipment to capture video of the first four days of camp.

Setup both stationary camera and mobile camera to capture multiple angles.

Attend all activities and meals in order to capture as much footage as possible.

Edit Video

Use rest time and evenings to edit video

Footage should be edited throughout the entire week

Produce Camp Video

Use Glen Lake computer and video editing software to design, edit, and produce camp video

Locate and purchase music for reproduction on camp video

Deliver Camp Video

Deliver final camp video to the Lead Staff to be shown on Friday at closing worship

Required Qualifications:

An active and growing faith in Jesus Christ, with a heart for ministry and a passion for serving others.

Integrity and consistent work ethic

A team-oriented servant attitude and the ability to relate well with others.

Interpersonal communication and organizational skills

The ability to handle conflict in a respectful and professional manner

Some college or at least 2 years out of high school

Desire and ability to work with children and adults OUTDOORS

Previous experience in residential camping and videography

Prior experience in supervising others especially peers is desirable

Physical Aspects of the Position:

Ability to communicate and work with groups participating and provide necessary instruction to campers and staff

Ability to observe camper behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures, and apply appropriate behavior-management techniques

Ability to observe staff behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures, and apply appropriate management techniques

Visual and auditory ability to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to the activity

Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid. Must be able to assist campers in an emergency (fire, evacuation, illness, or injury) and possess strength and endurance required to maintain constant supervision of campers.

Additional Physical Requirements:

Some physical requirements of a program position could be endurance including standing, some bending, stooping, and stretching. Requires eye-hand coordination and manual dexterity to manipulate program equipment and program activities. Requires normal range of hearing and eyesight to record, prepare, and communicate appropriate camper activities/programs. Willingness to live in a camp setting and work irregular hours delivering program in the facility available. Operate with daily exposure to the sun and heat and varying weather conditions.

The Video Specialist will adhere to the principles of confidentiality concerning the business of this ministry.
